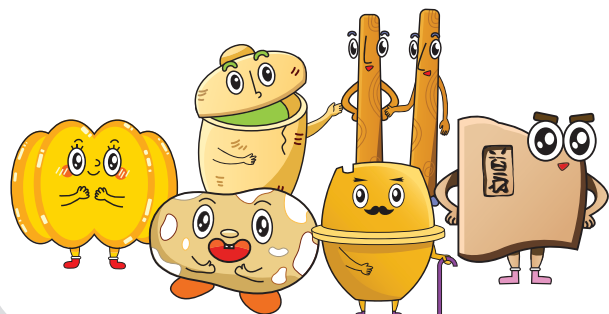

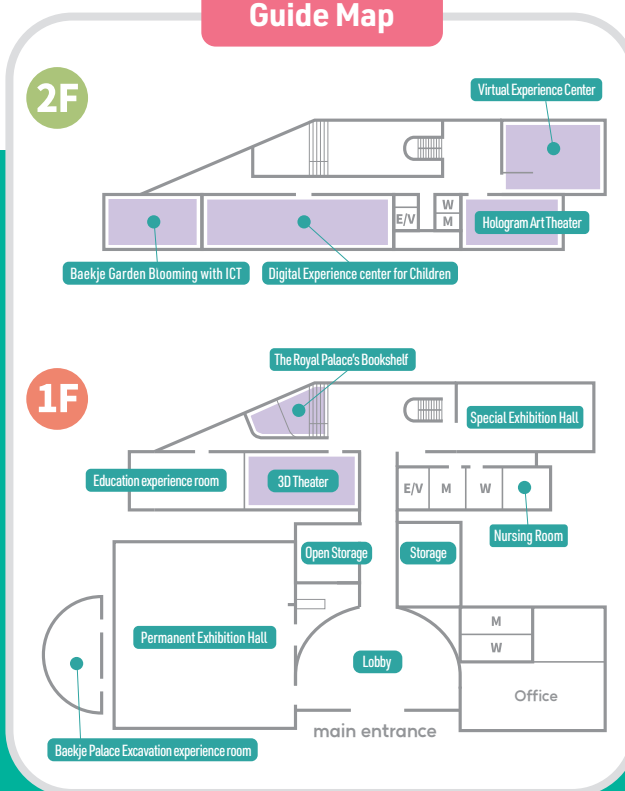
The Baekje Royal Palace Virtual Experience Center is an hands-on exhibition of 'Baekje Royal Palace' using ICT.

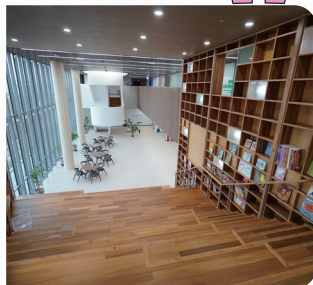
3D Theater 1F

A place to share knowledge with precious donated books



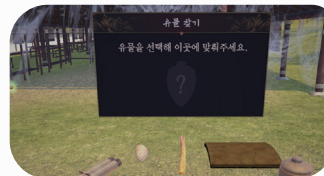
